



Safety Rules for Indoor Shooting

1. All members are responsible to monitor the shooting control and safety of any people in the area.
2. Range Safety Officers (RSO) must verify that all shooters are aware of and understand the range operating and safety instructions.
3. The RSO may stop the "shoot" if he/she identifies a safety concern.
4. The RSO has the right to not permit an individual to participate if it is felt the individual is not safe or has violated any of the range safety rules.
5. In the event of an accident the RSO will take the necessary action.
6. Never nock an arrow or shoot your bow unless you are in the designated shoot area.
7. Only target/fieldpoints may be used.
8. No alcoholic beverages or intoxicating substances may be carried or consumed at the range.
9. Never point an arrow at another person.
10. Wait for "safe to shoot" before approaching shooting line, and stay behind the shooting line until "ALL CLEAR".
11. If picking up missed arrows, one member should stay in front of target to ensure that the next group does not start shooting.
12. A "CEASE FIRE" command : Shooting stops immediately.
13. Archers will shoot a maximum of 3 arrows per end except in special circumstances. Shooting more is counter-productive, damages targets and is impolite.
14. When all archers have finished and "all clear" sounded, arrows may be collected.
15. All shooters should straddle the shooting line with one foot in front and one foot behind.
16. To save targets: Targets where the kill zone is easily replaced should be shot only in :kill area:.
17. Walk, never run toward targets.
18. Do not use damaged equipment.
19. Beginning archers should shoot closer targets.
20. In the interest of safety and to save targets use poundage below 50 lbs.
21. Arrows should not be shot in a "safe area".
